

**Due to the COVID-19 epidemic we will not be doing the Double-Up (Cluster) Auditions this season. Each show will have a separate audition date.**

Lemon Bay Playhouse is not doing dual auditions this season. Each show will have a separate audition date\*. We have chosen to do separate and virtual auditions for *Art of Murder* and *Almost, Maine*. To accomplish this, we will send out a link to our actor database and post the link on Facebook. The link will be used to submit a video of your audition by the date requested. Directors will preview the videos and either do a zoom or a voice call follow-up meeting. The show will be cast after the follow-up meeting is completed.

The *Art of Murder* video deadline is Monday, November 15<sup>th</sup>. Call backs will be November 22 and 23, 2020.

The *Almost, Maine* video deadline is Monday, January 4<sup>th</sup>. Call backs will be January 10 and 11, 2021.

We are hopeful that the auditions will be live for the last two plays of the season. The auditions for *Now and Then* is planned for February 21 and 22, 2021 while auditions for *Baggage* are planned for April 18 and 19, 2021. Sides for the auditions will be available for download from our website. Scripts will be available for perusal at the box office for the shows that have auditions after November 30.
